

The Christmas Eve service that we are so

familiar with has a long history in the church. It is, at heart, modified from the Easter Vigil service. The Vigil of Easter has songs accompanied by candlelight, a number of readings interspersed with hymns, and takes place at sundown as we celebrate the return of light into the world. The Christmas Eve service does these same things — we sing "Silent Night" with candles, we hear the Nativity story while we sing carols, and we praise God after nightfall, again to celebrate the coming of light into the world.

Throughout Advent we will look to John, who points to the Messiah, and in this way our Christmas service itself points to Easter. Hopefully, this will serve to remind us of what the season is about (especially when retailers have their own agenda for the meaning of Christmas – this year some are opening at 6 pm on Thanksgiving, and will be open until 10 pm on Christmas eve) and point us, even at Christmas, to the cross.

As Christmas comes, we celebrate a Servant King, an Incarnate God. We remember that the one who creates the universe loves us enough not just to live with us, but to die with us, and rise with us.
