But this year, the wind has never been calm enough for long enough for me to feel I can do it safely, so I haven't. We will use a previous year's ash this year. I miss the smell of the burning leaves, which smell so different from other kinds of smoke. But the thing about burning leaves to make ash is that you don't need much. The pile of leaves becomes a small bowl of ashes. But I only need a handful of ash for everyone's forehead.

Part of Lent's message is about getting rid of the things you don't need, that draw you away from what you do. If the process of winnowing down from a pile to a bowl to a handful leaves you with what is truly necessary, then it is a good and useful process, emblematic of our Lenten journey.

This Lent, if you look to remove something from your life, make sure it's something that draws you away from God, something unnecessary, so that you might be drawn closer to God.
